

## IAVS 2023 - Australia The Future of Vegetation in the 22<sup>nd</sup> Century

Dear colleagues,

I would like to extend a warm invitation to IAVS members and Australian and international organisations to participate in IAVS 2023, a symposium focusing on The Future of Vegetation in the 22<sup>nd</sup> Century. The 65<sup>th</sup> Annual Symposium of the International Association for Vegetation Science will be held at Opal Cove Resort in the beautiful city of Coffs Harbour, on the North Coast of New South Wales, Australia, from 4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> September 2023. ### **Symposium Theme**

### IAVS 2023 - Australia The Future of Vegetation in the 22<sup>nd</sup> Century

IAVS 2023 is the annual symposium of the International Association for Vegetation Science. IAVS is a worldwide union of scientists and others interested in theoretical and practical studies of vegetation: its composition and structure, history, classification, distribution, ecology, dynamics, management and uses in the landscape.

Each annual symposium is held in a different part of the world and is themed. The main theme of IAVS 2023 is The Future of Vegetation in the 22<sup>nd</sup> Century. Given rapid advances in technology and our understanding of vegetation science, coupled with evidence of accelerating climate change, and increasing tensions globally due to geopolitical, environmental and social turmoil, IAVS 2023 affords an important opportunity to take stock of planetary vegetation currently, the outlook and challenges for the biosphere by 2100, and appropriate responses now that will afford the best prospects for life on Earth in the next century.

Other subthemes are being promoted as part of IAVS 2023. Australian vegetation is highly distinctive on a global stage, both its structure and floristic composition, due to the continent's southern position in Pangaea and Gondwana since the Palaeozoic, and the long period of isolation through the Tertiary as the Gondwana rainforests that covered the Australian tectonic plate continued to evolve and ultimately recede as Australia broke away from Antarctica and drifted north towards the equator. As the continent passed through the middle latitudes and dried, Australia's distinctive contemporary native flora evolved from the southern Gondwanic ancestral elements, radiating in the largely monsoon, desert and seasonally dry temperate environments found today. However, around Coffs Harbour and in refugial pockets along the entire Great Dividing Range and in Tasmania, are remnants of the once extensive rainforests that covered Gondwana in the Cretaceous and early Tertiary. IAVS 2023 will allow international delegates to see and appreciate the vestiges of the Gondwana rainforests that once covered the southern supercontinent.

Another important subtheme of IAVS 2023 is vegetation management broadly conceived. Native vegetation the world over is subjected to changing societal needs and policy objectives as well as increasing biophysical and socioeconomic stresses. The result is a shrinking resource of native ecosystems of high conservation value, an expanding estate of degraded environments less able to satisfy societal needs as well as increasing areas of custom-designed novel ecosystems to meet specific community demands for products and services. Effective management of vegetation in all of these states across a range of scales is key to achieving optimal outcomes for society now and in the future. IAVS 2023 will thus feature a range of specialist symposia focused on best-practice vegetation management for a wide range of outcomes, from biodiversity conservation and the mounting pressures from climate change, biosecurity threats, and diverse anthropogenic impacts, to management for specific as well as multiple products, services and societal goals (e.g. carbon sequestration; agricultural, timber and water production; biodiversity credits; fire management, and cultural healing and reconciliation).

## **Coffs Harbour and Environs**

### **City of Pristine Beaches, Emerald Forests and Azure Seas**

Coffs Harbour, a nature lover's paradise, is located on the mid north coast of New South Wales, Australia, approximately half way between Sydney and Brisbane. The Gumbaynggirr are the original people of the Coffs Harbour region. Coffs Harbour is known for its uncrowded beaches and as a tranquil seaside nature destination for visitors and tourists. It is surrounded by World Heritage-listed national parks and state forests and is the only location in NSW where the Great Dividing Range meets the ocean. In the waters off Coffs Harbour Marina is the Solitary Islands Marine Park, home to abundant wildlife, migrating whales in autumn and spring, and coral reefs. Adjacent to the marina is the Muttonbird Island Nature Reserve, with its large breeding population of wedge-tailed shearwaters and learning centre.

Coffs Harbour has a population of about 72,000 and is one of the largest urban centres in northern NSW. It boasts an abundance of attractions and recreation experiences, excellent shopping, fantastic accommodation and award-winning cuisine.

Coffs Harbour's economy was once based on timber, fishing and agriculture (dairy, beef and bananas). Over recent decades, tourism has become increasingly important. Today the tourist city is part of a wider region known as the Coffs Coast. Coffs Harbour hosts the National Marine Science Centre as well as a campus of Southern Cross University, a campus of the University of New South Wales' Rural Faculty of Medicine, a public and a private hospital, several radio stations, and three major shopping centres.

There are regular passenger flights each day to Sydney, Melbourne and Brisbane departing from Coffs Harbour Airport. Coffs Harbour is accessible by road, NSW TrainLink, and by regular bus services.

Coffs Harbour has a humid subtropical climate (Cfa in the Köppen climate classification system) with markedly seasonal rainfall. The city is relatively sunny, receiving 122 clear days annually. Summers are moderately hot, wet and humid, and winters are mild with moderate rainfall. Long-term (1943–2015) mean annual rainfall is 1705 mm, and mean annual temperature is 18.7°C. September has a comfortable mean daily maximum and minimum of 22°C and 11°C, respectively, and is normally relatively dry, with a mean monthly rainfall of 60 mm.
